

COLLABORATIVE AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

KING'S COLLEGE LONDON

AND

FUNDACIÓN PARA EL FUTURO DE COLOMBIA

King's College London (hereafter KCL) of the UK and *Fundación para el Futuro de Colombia* (COLFUTURO) of the Republic of Colombia hereinafter designated as "The Parties";

DECLARE:

Preamble:

Since the original agreement between the Parties was signed in 1<sup>st</sup> October 2011, both KCL and COLFUTURO have worked in a highly cooperative manner for their mutual benefit. In recognition of the existing and mutual beneficial relationship between KCL and COLFUTURO, and in support of their aims of the COLFUTURO Programa Semilleros, the Parties now agree that:

KCL will provide support to one Semilleros de Talento Masters scholar per year to study for any Masters programme at KCL. The support being offered is a full tuition fee-waiver for one student who has already received an unconditional offer of admission from a 12 month Masters programme at KCL, under the following conditions:

1. Colombian students interested in this Scholarship will seek admission to the Master's degree programs offered by KCL, following the normal application procedures and meeting all the standard admission requirements (including official language tests) established by KCL.
2. The potential candidates will be from COLFUTURO's *Programa Semillero de Talentos*.
3. The selection of the recipient of the scholarship will be decided by KCL, COLFUTURO will provide a list of the potential candidates.
4. The potential candidates must have successfully completed the established COLFUTURO selection process.
5. The student must be in receipt of an unconditional offer letter from KCL for a Masters program. The student must have obtained the offer via the usual graduate application and selection procedure.
6. COLFUTURO will inform their nominated students by 15<sup>th</sup> July at the latest.
7. KCL reserves the right to refuse the nomination proposed by COLFUTURO, in which case COLFUTURO will be required to nominate another potential candidate.
8. The scholarship will be only given to cover tuition fees for a one year masters programme.

Each party will designate a Coordinator who will be in charge of implementing and evaluating the fellowships program, and maintaining communication


